- ✓ Review and plan all activities to avoid injury or damage to property which might occur as a result of our operations or ongoing business development or improvement.
- ✓ Provide occupational health assessment, monitoring and measurement of its employees to promote a proactive approach to health, safety and welfare.
- ✓ Provide effective supervision, instruction, information and training to ensure the health and safety of employees and others who may be affected by our operations and activities is clearly defined and understood at all levels.
- ✓ Provide working conditions that comply with all UK Health & Safety legislation focusing on best practice guidance where appropriate legislation does not exist.
- ✓ Investigate all accidents and incidents throughout the business to ensure that root cause analysis is established and appropriate corrective and preventative actions are implemented.
- ✓ Regularly review and report on our health and safety performance to all levels, implementing any corrective actions. We will actively encourage employee involvement at all levels of the business.
- ✓ Effectively communicate this policy to all employees and interested parties ensuring that its content is fully understood by all.
- ✓ Provide necessary and adequate resources, both financial and human, to ensure the full implementation of this policy.
